PARADE RULES

1. The theme "Watermelon Rivalries" must be carried out in the decoration of all entries. Entries must participate in the entire parade route to be eligible for cash awards. All parade participants are responsible for picking up their trash and litter in the line-up area. Please bring trash bags and keep the school area clean.
2. Entries will receive their line-up numbers the afternoon of the parade, during the check-in and line-up. The number should be displayed on the front passenger side of the entry. **Entries must be in position in the line-up area at the VHS gym no later than 5:00pm.**
3. Judging criteria for all categories (1) Adherence to theme (2) Creative originality (3) Decorative appearance (4) Costume and sound.
4. Horse entries will be judged on: (1) Rider's appearance and dress (2) Appearance of the horse (3) Tack and decoration (4) Adherence to theme. A negative Coggins test is required for all horses in parade area and along parade route.
5. Assigned number must be visible for the judges and the announcer. Vehicles are to place their number on the passenger side front bumper. Walkers and horseback riders will pin parade number on tack or rider.
6. **Entries will be judged at 5:00 pm BEFORE THE PARADE. Judges' decisions will be final. Awards will be paid to the group as it is listed on the entry form.**
7. Floats are trailers sponsored by a business or individual. Non-commercial floats are those entered by private individuals or sponsored by a non-profit or civic group. Commercial floats are those representing a business.
8. Parade Route: south on Section Line Rd, west at Harris Street, north on Dalton St, east on the north side of the Assembly of God church, south on Wolf St, east on Lover's Lane, south on Section Line road, back to the high school gym. For children walking pets or pulling wagons, notify parade official if unable to walk 1.6 mile route. Parade route is NOT on Hwy 70.
9. Maintain 2-3 car lengths between entries to avoid gaps or crunches.
10. Only walking people are permitted to toss candy, gum, or give water bottles to the observing crowd.
11. Awards will be mailed out Monday, July 29, 2019.
12. To avoid congestion and confusion, entrants must stay in the designated order given by the parade official at the line-up area. Entries are not allowed to enter the parade at a different location without prior approval from Parade Chairperson.
